ESSENTIAL INFORMATION TURKMENISTAN

PASSPORT AND VISA INFORMATION

Your passport needs to be valid for at least six (6) months after your journey ends, and should have a minimum of one (1) blank visa page for entry and exit stamps.

A tourist visa is required for U.S. and Canadian passport holders for entry into Turkmenistan and must be obtained prior to departure. A visa stamp in your passport can be obtained either by applying directly to a Turkmenistan consulate or through a visa processing service. While there are additional costs involved in using a visa service, this option is available for guests who prefer additional assistance in the visa process.

A letter of invitation from the Turkmenistan State Migration Service (SMS) must be submitted with your visa application. A&K will assist you in obtaining this invitation letter. In order to begin this process, please email a clear, full-color photograph or scan of your passport showing the full page including the two digital lines at the bottom of the page to A&K at: operations@abercrombiekent.com. The SMS requires at least 15 working days to process the certified letter of invitation which will then be forwarded to you by A&K so that you may apply for your tourist visa.

Turkmenistan Immigration Card: In addition to a tourist visa, visitors are also required to purchase an immigration card on arrival. The current fee is USD \$14 (subject to change without notice.) The fee <u>must</u> be paid in cash and can be paid in U.S. dollars. Two (2) passport-size photos and photocopy of your passport are also required. You must carry this card with you for the duration of your stay in Turkmenistan, and then return it to customs authorities on departure.

COVID-19 COUNTRY ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & TRAVEL ADVISORIES

The following are the current COVID-19 screening requirements for entry into Turkmenistan for U.S. and Canadian residents Visit the U.S. Department of State at travel.state.gov or the Government of Canada at travel.gc.ca/travelling/advisories for up-to-date information and travel advisories. All requirements are subject to change.

- All travellers (ages 18 and over) entering Turkmenistan must present one of the following:
 - An original COVID-19 vaccination certificate indicating full vaccination completed at least 42 days before arrival. The current approved vaccines are Pfizer (Comirnaty), Moderna

(Spikevax), AstraZeneca (Vaxzevria) and Janssen/Johnson & Johnson (Ad26.COV2.S). To meet changing requirements, a booster shot is recommended.

- Documented proof of a recovery confirming the presence of antibodies issued at most 48 hours before departure from the first embarkation point.
- All travellers must complete a Health Declaration form on arrival and take a governmentadministered COVID-19 PCR test (approximately USD \$45). Guests who tests positive for COVID-19, will be subject to mandatory quarantine in a government facility for three to seven days.

CASH & CREDIT CARDS

Turkmenistan has a primarily cash-based economy. Major credit cards are not widely accepted, except at large hotels, shops and restaurants catering to international visitors and costly service charges may apply. ATM access is extremely limited; some machines can be found in Ashgabat, and Vnesheconombank locations.

PLEASE PACK YOUR PATIENCE

Turkmenistan is a developing nation that has experienced significant reforms in their economic and political institutions over the last several decades; however, the country is still in the process of developing its tourist infrastructure.
