SEP 25 BORDEAUX | INTOXICATING ART DE VIVRE

Alternatively, delve into Bordeaux's rich wine heritage with a tour and tasting at a local estate. SEP 26 BILBAO, SPAIN | SHIMMERING ART IN BASQUE COUNTRY

SEP 27 SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA | HALLOWED GROUND

Alternatively, choose a shorter walk to Cape Finisterre, the last stop on the Camino de Santiago, followed by a visit to the medieval castle of Vimianzo. For another option, explore Santiago's bustling food market and restaurants, tasting local tapas, empanadas, cheeses and wines.
